

## Parker "Conservation Pricing"

New Rates effective January 1, 2005

Parker Water's rates are in the mid-range for water providers in the metro-Denver region. Parker uses "conservation pricing" to encourage low water use. Under the system, customers are charged a higher rate for water usage above certain levels. The pricing structure has helped Parker Water reduce water use by 39 percent in recent years. PWSD also collects a \$5.00/month "Storm Water" fee on behalf of the Town of Parker.
